

PREPPING FOR FALL: STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

There are many sources of stormwater pollution unique to autumn, and we need your help to control them!

LEAVES

The leaves will start to fall soon, and their improper disposal poses a threat to our water resources; local streams and creeks which lead to the Kanawha and Coal Rivers where we get our tap water.

Leaf litter and any yard waste dumped into a stormwater drain or near a waterway can cause harmful nutrient accumulation. Leaves, much like grass clippings, swept into the street can easily enter storm drains and make their way into the nearest creek, as well as well as clog drains and cause flooding.

The main issue with fall foliage entering a stormwater system is that leaf litter contributes phosphorus and nitrogen to water. While 'nutrients' like these may sound like a positive additive, in excess they can cause what is known as eutrophication, and can also produce harmful algal blooms.

Dispose of leaf litter and yard waste in a compost pile and never in the street or stream! You can shred yard and leaf waste to use as mulch or fertilizer for your yard and garden. Or, check with Saint Albans' Public Works department for yard waste collection opportunities.

LANDSCAPING

If you are working on a landscaping project in your yard this season, bare soil can also run off into streams and cause sediment pollution, so let's keep our soil in place!

DID YOU KNOW?

Global warming could effect fall foilage.
As temperatures remain warmer through fall and winter nights, they could delay the beloved fall color shift; One 2013 study found that fall colors now arrive a week later than they did 20 years ago.

FERTILIZER & SEEDS

Fall is the best time for seeding and fertilizing your lawn. However, if excess fertilizer is applied it cannot be absorbed by the soil and will wash away with the rain.


Do not use fertilizers immediately before a rainstorm, and do not apply them in excess. Always follow the directions on the bottle for safe application and disposal whenever you use a chemical product.

GUTTERS

Fall is a great time to clean our your gutters. Leaves can build up in your gutters and decay causing them to be ineffective and adding excess harmful nutrients to stormwater.
