WHAT IS CONSIDERED HAZARDOUS?

Hazardous waste is a waste with properties that make it potentially dangerous or harmful to human health or the environment. The scope of hazardous wastes is very large and diverse. Hazardous wastes can be liquids, solids, or contained gases.

In regulatory terms, a hazardous waste is a waste that appears on one of the four Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) hazardous wastes lists (F-list, K-list, P-list, or U-list) or that exhibits one of the four characteristics of a hazardous waste – ignitability, corrosivity, reactivity, or toxicity. However, materials can be hazardous wastes even if they are not specifically listed or don't exhibit any characteristic of a hazardous waste, such as used oil.
