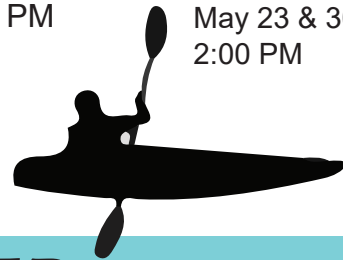

### 953.11 THROWING OR SCATTERING GARBAGE; PERMITTING PREMISES TO BECOME UNSANITARY.

No person shall throw, place or scatter any garbage, rubbish, trash, grass clippings, leaves or yard debris or other refuse over or upon any premises, street or alley, sewer or drainage basin, either public or private, or adjacent thereto, and either with or without the intent to later remove or burn the same, or permit from the accumulation of refuse, any premises owned, occupied or controlled by any such person to become or remain offensive, unsanitary, unsightly, unsafe to the public health or a fire hazard. (Ord. 98-03. Passed 2-2-98.)
